This is work for Thursday 7th and Friday 8th January. Below you will find a numeracy link, literacy activity for your child to complete each day and a learning task based on our new topic 'Street Detectives'. As well as these activities your child should read daily and practice their times tables on TT Rock Stars.

Thursday

Numeracy: This time we are using Oak National Academy for daily maths lessons, instead of White Rose.

Use the link on the website for Year 2 or Year 3 as appropriate. If the work is too hard then use the daily lesson for a lower age group.

Watch the video and complete the tasks as it goes along.

Literacy: On Tuesday in phonics we were looking at the 'ow' phoneme which can be spelt 'ou' or 'ow'. Make a list of as many words with the 'ow' phoneme as you can.

Draw a picture of a boy or girl on one half of A4 paper. Draw a bubble map on other half to describe what they look like, make sure they give the character a name! Use lots of adjectives e.g. 'short black hair', 'long red coat'.

Learning task; Go into your garden and look carefully at the outside of your house. Make a careful observational drawing of what you see.

Friday

Numeracy: See Thursday's notes.

Literacy: Phonics - practise reading 'ow' phoneme words in the following sentences -

I found out about the brown cow.

A wise owl can turn its head right round.

We had a row about the loud sounds.

Look at the bubble map that you drew yesterday, write 4 sentences to describe your character.

Learning task; Draw and label a design for your own fantasy home. What will your home be built from? How will you get in and out of your house? What will you have in your garden? Make a model of your fantasy house using junk materials.
