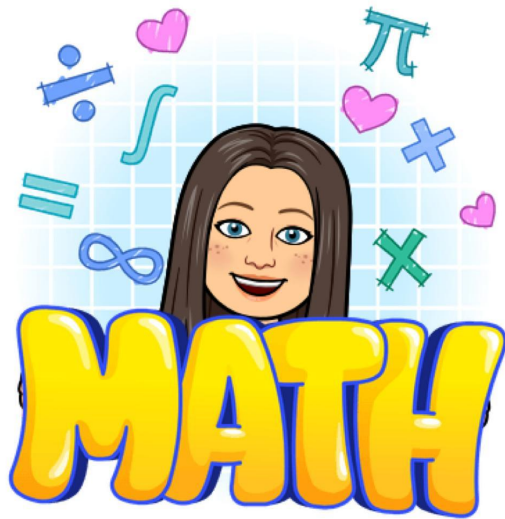

Alternatively, you can try the colour of their Guided Reading book, although this may be slightly more challenging. The children are used to using Oxfordowl in school and are familiar with it.

Click on **My Class Login** and enter the username **BallasallaRowan**.

The password is **rowan**.

Once you have gained access click on My Bookshelf and then you will be able to chose to read books from different age groups. You can also listen to the audio as you read along.
